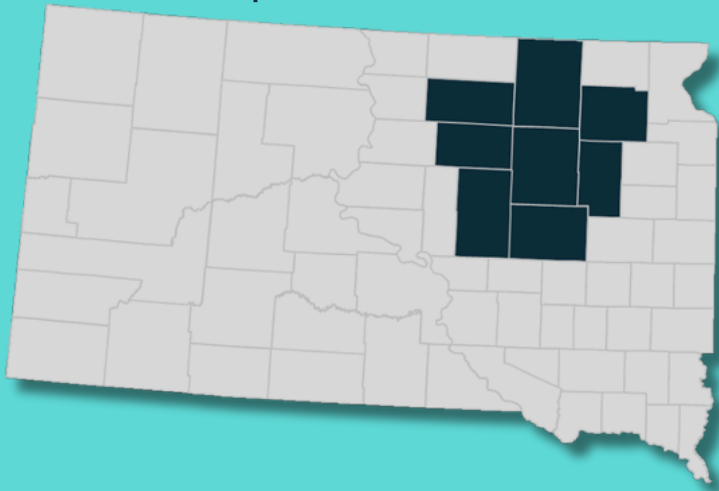

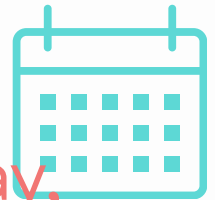

Practice Type	RCPP Payment Rate
No-Till/Strip Till (from Conventional Till)	<b>\$61/acre</b>
No-Till/Strip Till (from Reduced Till)	<b>\$39/acre</b>
Reduce Till (from Conventional Till)	<b>\$22/acre</b>
Nutrient Management ("4R")	<b>\$40/acre</b>
Cover Crops	<b>\$54/acre</b>
"Early Adopter" Management Fee	<b>\$2,500/year</b>



## Project Objectives

- 5-year contracts with farmers in eligible counties to adopt approved conservation practices
- Work with a team of land-grant universities and soil scientists to measure and verify the GHG benefits of the practices
- Empower farmers and ethanol producers to benefit from tax credits and earn premium prices in clean fuel markets
- Conclusively verify conservation practice benefits through our land grant and Department of Energy partners
